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proventents or fixtures, and, unless this Deed of Trust is being given to secure an extension of consumer credit requiring disclosures under the Adders Truth-in-Lending Act, Graitor also hereby grants to Lender a Uniform Commercial Code security interest in all fixtures, equipment, furnishings and other pricies of personal property now or subsequently located on or used in connection with the property; all of the foregoing is collectively referred to as the Property. Gram or haraby assigns to Lender as additional security for the Indebtedness all present and future rents, leases, and

profits from the Property.

Maintenance of the Property.

1.1 The Property shall be maintained in good condition at all times. Grantor shall promptly make all necessary repairs, replacements and renewals so that the value of the Property shall be maintained, and Grantor shall not commit or permit any waste on the Property. Grantor shall comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations and private restrictions affecting the Property.
