The Klamath Tribe (also known as the Klamath Tribes of Southern Oregon), a federally recognized Indian tribe in Oregon, grantor, hereby conveys to the United States of America in trust for the Klamath Tribe, grantee, all rights, title, and interest in and to the following described real property:

The SW1/4 of Section 34, Township 35 South,
Range 11 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath
County, Oregon.

The true consideration for this conveyance is none for the conversion of fee title to trust.

This conveyance is subject to all valid existing rights, including liens and outstanding taxes, and is made pursuant to 25 U.S.C.A. § 566d.

This instrument will not allow use of the property described in this instrument in violation of applicable land use laws and regulations. Before signing or accepting this instrument, the persons acquiring fee title to the property should check with the appropriate city or county planning department to verify approved uses.

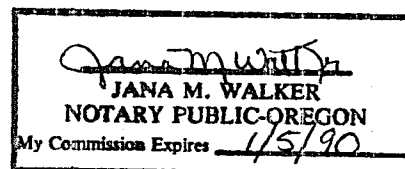
