

DEED

The Klamath Tribe, a federally recognized Indian tribe in Oregon, grantor, hereby releases and quitclaims to the United States of America in trust for the Klamath Tribe, grantee, all rights, title, and interest in and to the following described real property:

The South one-half of the Southeast one-quarter of Section 15, Township 36 South, Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian, EXCEPTING that portion deeded to Tilda Chocktoot Chavez as recorded in Volume 334, page 11 of the deed records of Klamath County, Oregon and further excepting that portion deeded to Beatty United Methodist Church, an Oregon non-profit corporation, and the Oregon-Idaho Conference of the United Methodist Church, an Oregon not-for-profit corporation, as recorded in Volume M88 page 14024, Deed Records of Klamath County, Oregon, which is Parcel 2 as shown on Minor Partition Map 1-88 as recorded by the County Clerk, Klamath County, Oregon and also excepting any land lying within public road right-of-ways; consisting of approximately 72.5 acres more or less.

The true consideration for this conveyance is none for the conversion of fee title to trust.

This conveyance is subject to all valid existing rights, including liens and outstanding taxes, and is made pursuant to 25 U.S.C.A. § 566d.

This instrument will not allow use of the property described in this instrument in violation of applicable land use laws and regulations. Before signing or accepting this instrument, the persons acquiring fee title to the property should check with the appropriate city or county planning department to verify approved uses.

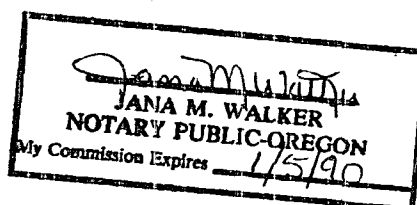
