

DEED

The Klamath Tribe, a federally recognized Indian tribe in Oregon, grantor, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the United States of America in trust for the Klamath Tribe, grantee, all rights, title, and interest in and to the following described real property.

A triangular parcel beginning at the Southeast corner of Section 24, Township 36 South, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian, thence North along said Section line 841.5 feet (51 rods); thence in Southwesterly direction to the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of Southeast 1/4 of said Section; thence East along the South line of said Section to the point of beginning, being 12.75 acres, more or less.

The true consideration for this conveyance is none for the conversion of fee title to trust.

This conveyance is subject to all valid existing rights, including liens and outstanding taxes, and is made pursuant to 25 U.S.C.A. § 566d.

This instrument will not allow use of the property described in this instrument in violation of applicable land use laws and regulations. Before signing or accepting this instrument, the persons acquiring fee title to the property should check with the appropriate city or county planning department to verify approved uses.


