WARRANTY DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That CENLAR FEDERAL SAVINGS BANK herein after called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, hereinafter called the grantee, does hereby bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditament and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of KLAMATH and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

LOTS 11 and 12, BLOCK 37, MALIN, IN THE COUNTY OF KLAMATH, STATE OF OREGON.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns forever. And said grantor hereby covenants to and with said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances except covenants, conditions, restrictions and easements of record and that grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, sated in terms of dollars, is \$ 14,346.00. However, the actual consideration consists of or includes other property or value given or promised which is the whole consideration.

In construing this deed and where the context so requires, the singular includes the plural and all grammatical changes shall be implied to make the provisions hereof apply equally to corporations and to individuals.
