DESIGNATING PERSON TO PERFORM
DUTIES OF DEBTOR, APPOINTING
TRUSTEE AND FIXING BONDTERENCE DUNN, CLERK
BY 70 DEPUTY

Debtor(s).

On consideration of the petition filed against the above-named debtor(s), and the court finding that entry of an order for relief against the debtor(s) is appropriate.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Relief under Chapter 7 of Title 11 of the United States Code is granted.

2. (If debtor is not an individual) Lester B. Jones, who represents the debtor in the capacity of President, is designated pursuant to Rule 9001(5) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure to perform the duties imposed upon the debtor corporation by Title 11 of the United States Code and in particular by §521 and by Rule 1007 of the Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

3. The debtor (or designated person) SHALL ATTEND the first meeting of creditors at the time, date and place later to be fixed by the court, AND SHALL EITHER:

(a) FILE IN TRIPLICATE WITHIN 15 DAYS of this order a cover sheet, schedules of all property and debts of the debtor, a statement of affairs, and Exhibit C (Current Income and Expenses); AND, if the debtor is an individual, timely file a §521(2) Statement of Intent as to Secured Property;

OR (b) [If debtor(s) fail to comply with paragraph 3(a) above] APPEAR BEFORE THE COURT AT 1:00 p.m. on July 31, 1989 in Bankruptcy Courtroom #429, United States Federal Building, 211 East 7th St., Eugene, Oregon and, explain the reasons, if any, for your failure to obey a lawful order of the Court. If you do not adequately explain your failure to obey, the Court may (1) order a third person to perform the duties mentioned above and enter a judgment against you to pay such person reasonable compensation for the services performed and other reasonable costs; (2) deny your discharge for failure to obey a lawful order of the court; or (3) order such other relief as the Court may deem appropriate.
