KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Gertrude E. Larimer

hereinafter called the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

The East half of Lot 674 in Block 107 of Mills Addition to the City of Klamath Falls, Oregon

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns forever.

and that grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.
