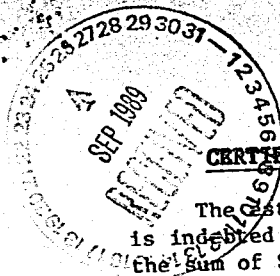

CERTIFICATE OF DISCHARGE OF PROPERTY FROM FEDERAL TAX LIEN

The Estate of Dorothy M. Stanley, identifying number 544-07-1719, is indebted to the United States for unpaid Internal Revenue Tax in the sum of Seventy-two thousand, two hundred nineteen and 08/100 Dollars (\$72,219.08) specifically, Federal Estate Tax imposed by Chapter 11 of subtitle B of the Internal Revenue Code.

To ensure the collection of said tax, notice of the lien of the United States was filed with the County Clerk, for the County of Klamath, State of Oregon, on November 5, 1979.

The lien of the United States for said tax attached to certain property described as:

See attached Exhibit "A" which is incorporated herein as if reproduced herein.

The District Director of Internal Revenue has determined that the value of the United States interest in the property described above, under and by virtue of the tax lien identified above, amounts to the sum of Twenty-two thousand, nine hundred twenty-five and 75/100 (\$22,925.75) and has authorized the issuance of a certificate discharging the property described above from the tax lien of the United States upon payment of the sum of \$22,925.75, the receipt by me which is hereby acknowledged.

Therefore, I, Carolyn Leonard, District Director of Internal Revenue at Portland, Oregon, do discharge the property described above from the tax lien identified above, reserving, however, the force and effect of the tax lien against any other property, wherever situated, to which the lien attaches.
