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DEARBORN, of Klamath Count, Oregon, did on the 3rd day of November, 1955, make, execute, publish and declare my Last Will and Testament in writing bearing date the day and year above mentioned, and

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WHEREAS, Paragreph Fifth of said Last Will and Testament contains the nomination and appointment of my brother, MYRON W. DEARBORN, to act in the place and stead of my wife, GRACE E. DEARBORN, should she be unable to act as executrix as nominated and appointed in said Paragraph Fifth of my said Last Will and Testament,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHARLES W. DEARBORN, being of a sound and disposing mind, do make, publish and declare the following as a Codicil to my Last Will and Testament in the following manner:
