Written arguments were then submitted to the court on behalf of the respective parties, and the court having reviewed the written arguments of the parties and at the special instance and request of the plaintiffs having issued his letter opinion October 13, 1989, containing conclusions of law and a proposed decree of specific performance; findings of and the plaintiffs having requested additional findings of fact and amendments to those facts previously found; and the court having reviewed plaintiffs' request and thereupon issued additional findings of fact on November 3, 1989, supplementing the original findings which concluded that plaintiffs were entitled to the relief prayed for in plaintiffs, complaint;

## ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The defendants, and each of them, are ordered to convey to plaintiffs as tenants by the entirety, the real property described as:

"That certain tract of land lying in Government Lot 2, Section Nine (9), Township Forty-one (41) South, Range Thirteen (13) West, Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe driven at a point 450.5 feet South and 570.8 feet West of the Northeast corner of said Government Lot 2; thence South 38° 42' East 291.35 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 89° 41' East 217.8 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe driven on the approximate southwesterly boundary of Ocean View Drive; (this bearing sometimes called East); thence northwesterly following the southwesterly boundary of said road to a point that bears North 70° 58' East from the point of beginning; thence South 70° 58' West 111.3 feet to the point of beginning."

The conveyance to be made by good and sufficient warranty deed within thirty days of the date of entry of this judgment, on payment by plaintiffs of the sum of \$10,000.00 cash plus the delivery of the Pang Ram Kachina depicted in Exhibit 2, said Kachina to be in a display case containing pieces of broken pottery; said payment and delivery to be made within thirty days of the date of this judgment.

- 2. The escrow for closure of the sale shall be held at Curry County Title, 610 Chetco Avenue, Brookings, Oregon.
- 3. Plaintiffs and defendant Ronald K. Rima will share equally all closing costs.
- 4. The \$10,000.00 to be paid in by plaintiffs, shall upon closure of the sale by Curry County Title, be paid over in full to defendant Mikael Beno.
- 5. Plaintiffs shall further have judgment against defendant Ronald K. Rima for costs and disbursements herein taxed in the sum of  $\frac{359.14}{00}$  and a reasonable attorney fee in the sum of  $\frac{80.00}{00}$ .
