GENERAL POWER OF ATTORNEY
(AR 608-50)

DATA REQUIRED BY THE PRIVACY ACT OF 1974. Prescribing Directive: AR 608-50. Authority: Title 10 USC 3012. Purpose: To enable an individual to appoint and empower another individual to transact all legal matters for the first individual with full legal authority. Uses: Used by individual concerned to transact legal matters. This form is not kept in the legal assistance office, but is given to the client who requests a power of attorney. Any information provided to an attorney or to clerical/secretarial personnel who work in legal assistance office is confidential and protected by the attorney-client privilege. Effect on individual not providing information: Voluntary. Failure to provide any or all information requested makes it impossible to draft the power of attorney properly.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that I, Douglas Eugene Norvell, a legal resident of King County, State of Washington, United States of America, now in the military service as a CPT/03, Social Security Number: 418-82-0376, in the Army of the United States, have made, constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint my wife, Kari Ellen Norvell, whose address is

5603 Woodlake Court, Fayetteville, North Carolina 28301, my true and lawful attorney to act in, manage, and conduct all my estate and all my affairs, and for that purpose, for me and in my name, place and stead, and for my use and benefit, and as my act and deed, to do and any of the following acts, deeds, and things, that is to say:

1. AUTHORITY TO PURCHASE PROPERTY: For me and in my name to purchase real property and for that purpose to borrow the necessary money to effect said purchase and giving said property as security for the loan; also, to sign, seal and deliver a bond or note for the payment thereof, and to sign, seal and deliver as collateral thereto, a mortgage or deed of trust upon said real estate with the usual power of sale, and interest and insurance, and other usual or customary provisions and covenants, and further, to execute and deliver any application forms or other documents necessary to obtain a loan for the purpose of purchasing such property.
2. AUTHORITY TO SELL HOUSE/PROPERTY: For me and in my name to grant, bargain and sell a house and lot and/or property owned by me, for such price and on such terms as my attorney-in-fact shall deem proper, and for me and in my name to make, execute, acknowledge and deliver good and sufficient deeds and conveyances for the same either with or without covenants and warranty. Further, to ask, demand, recover, collect and receive all sums of money which shall become due and owing to me by means of any such sale, conveyance or lease, to take all lawful ways and means for the recovery thereof, and to execute and deliver sufficient acquittances, releases, and discharges therefor, as well as of any lien or liens securing any obligation arising in connection therewith.
3. MANAGEMENT OF PROPERTY: To take, hold, possess, invest, lease, let, or otherwise manage any or all of my property or any interest therein; to eject, remove, or relieve tenants or other persons from, and recover possession of such property by rebuild, alter, modify, or improve the same or any part thereof, including the power to deliver my personal property into Government storage in accordance with applicable regulations of the Department of Defense and the armed service of which I am a member and to make, execute, and deliver any applications, vouchers, or powers of attorney required by the said regulations and in conformity therewith.
4. AUTHORITY TO SHIP PROPERTY: To take possession and order the removal and shipment of any of my property from or to any post, warehouse, depot, dock or other place of storage or safekeeping. Governmental certificate, to file claim or other instrument necessary or convenient for such purposes. In addition, to execute any and all claim forms in my behalf for any and allowances, compensation, and reimbursements payable to me by the Government of the United States or any agency or department whether governmental or civilian, including but not restricted to, allowances, and reimbursements payable to me by the Government of the United States or any agency or department whether governmental or civilian, authorized by law and regulation.
5. AUTHORITY TO EXTEND LIENS: To extend and renew all notes and liens executed by me or by my said attorney in fact upon such terms and conditions as he may deem proper.
6. AUTHORITY TO BUY AND SELL STOCKS AND BONDS: For me and in my name to buy and sell shares of stocks and bonds in my name and stead for my use and benefit. To buy, sell, assign, transfer, convey and settle all or any part of the shares of all U.S. Savings Bonds in my name.
7. AUTHORITY TO OPERATE/REGISTER/MAINTAIN/SELL/MOTOR VEHICLES: For me and in my name to take possession of, to operate, to register, to maintain, to insure and to file a claim for any and negligent damage occurring to any and all motor vehicles which I own or may own or have an interest in. In addition, to execute any and all documents or instruments necessary or proper to effect the proper sale and the proper transfer of title to any and all motor vehicles which I own or may own or have an interest in, to deliver the same documents or instruments to the proper persons and authority as required by law to effectuate such transfer, and to collect and give receipts for all monies paid in consideration of such sale and transfer, and hold said monies in my name for safekeeping until such delivery of said proceeds is made to me, my agent, or assigns, as I may designate.
8. AUTHORITY TO SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR MINOR: To authorize and provide for the any and all medical and hospital care and treatment deemed necessary by a duly licensed staff physician at any military hospital or non-military hospital whether within or without the territorial limits of the United States, whenever the services of a military hospital are not reasonably available for my lawful child(ren).
9. AUTHORITY TO ENDORSE CHECKS: To receive, endorse, present, negotiate, collect, and cash any and all checks, drafts, and other negotiable or nonnegotiable instruments payable to the order of the undersigned, this power expressly includes, but is not limited to the authority to receive, endorse, and cash checks drawn on the TREASURER OF THE UNITED STATES, and to apply for and sign all instruments and documents necessary to the receipt of duplicate checks payable to the order of the undersigned.
10. AUTHORITY TO DEPOSIT CHECKS: To deposit in my name and for my account with any bank, banker or trust company or other banking institution, all monies which may come into the hands of my said attorney as such attorney, and all bills of exchange, drafts, checks, promissory notes, and

AUTHORITY TO WITHDRAW MONIES FROM BANK: To act for me and in my name to withdraw any and all monies deposited in my name in any and all accounts with any and all Banks, and for that purpose to draw checks and drafts thereon in my name in the manner provided herein. 12. AUTHORITY TO FILE/CASH TAX RETURNS: For me and in my name to prepare and execute any tax returns, including, but not limited to, Federal Income Tax returns, State Income Tax returns, Social Security Tax returns, and Federal and State information and estimate returns; to execute any claims for refund or other Board or Court, Federal or State, consents and waivers to determination and assessment of taxes and consents and waivers agreeing to a later determination and an assessment of taxes that is provided by statute of limitations; to receive and endorse and collect any checks in settlement of any refund of taxes; to examine and to request and receive any copies of any tax returns, reports and other information from the United States Treasury Department or any other taxing authority, Federal or State, in connection with any of the foregoing matters. 13. AUTHORITY FOR COLLECTION OF DEBTS: To collect, sue for, compromise or otherwise dispose of any claim, debt, rents or share in an estate in which I now or hereafter may have an interest. To ask, demand, sue for, recover and receive all sums of money, debts, dues, goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, effects, and things of whatsoever nature or description which now or hereafter shall be or become due, owing, payable, or belonging to me in or by right, title, ways or means howsoever, and upon receipt thereof, or of any part thereof, to make, sign, execute, and deliver such receipts, releases, or other discharges for the same respectively as he shall think fit or be advised. 14. AUTHORITY TO ENDORSE SECURITIES: To endorse and negotiate for any and all purposes all promissory notes, bills of exchange, checks, drafts, or other negotiable or non-negotiable paper payable to me or to my order; to endorse for transfer all certificates of stock, bonds, or other securities; to endorse and cash U.S. Savings bonds and notes. 15. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY: To borrow money in my name when deemed necessary to my said attorney upon such terms as to my said attorney appear proper and to execute such instruments as may be requisite for such purpose. 16. AUTHORITY TO HAVE ACCESS TO SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX: To have access to any safe deposit box or boxes that may be now or hereafter rented by me or for me or standing in my name; to withdraw or remove any of the contents thereof and to make deposits in and otherwise use or surrender such box or boxes; and to rent any safe deposit box or boxes in my name or in both our names jointly either with or without right of survivorship. 17. AUTHORITY TO VOTE BY PROXY: For me and in my name to vote at the meetings of any company or companies and otherwise to act as my proxy or representative, and for that purpose to sign and execute any proxies or other instruments in my name and on my behalf. 18. To institute, maintain, defend, compromise, arbitrate or otherwise dispose of, any and all actions, suits, attachments or other legal proceedings for or against me.

GIVING AND GRANTING unto my said attorney, full power and authority to do and perform any and all and every act, deed, matter and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specially enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full, complete and general power herein granted, and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

And I hereby declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney shall be binding on myself, and my heirs, legal and personal representative, and assigns; whether the same shall have been done before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by said attorney; and whether or not I, the grantor of this instrument, shall have been reported or listed, either officially or otherwise, as "missing" or "missing in action" as those words are used in military parlance, it being the intent hereof that such status designation shall not bar my attorney from fully and completely exercising and continuing to exercise any and all powers and rights herein granted, and that such report of "missing" or "missing in action" shall neither constitute nor be interpreted as constituting notice of my death nor operate to revoke this instrument.

Unless otherwise revoked, the power granted herein shall expire on the 17th day of December, 1990.
