DECREE OF DISSOLUTION

Now on this 29th day of August, 1986 comes the parties hereto. Petitioner in person and with her attorney Emory Melton and Respondent in person and with his attorney John A. Lewright. Whereupon, this cause coming on to be heard and being called the parties announce ready for trial and the parties submit this cause to the Court upon there pleadings and proof and the Court after hearing the evidence finds as follows:

Petitioner has been a resident of Barry County. Missouri,
 for more than 90 days, next preceding the filing of the petition.
 More than 30 days have elapsed since the filing of the petition.

3. The Court has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of the petition.

4. The parties were legally married on September 14, 1962 in City

of Madera, State of California and the marriage is registered there. 5. The parties separated on July 10, 1985, and have since

5. The parties separated; there is no reasonable likelihood that that time remained separated; there is no reasonable likelihood that the marriage of the parties can be preserved and therefore the marriage is irretrievably broken.

6. The Court finds that there is one child of Petitioner and Respondent to-wit: Kristi Conner. age 11, said child was in the actual custody of Petitioner at the time of the institution of this action and at the time of the granting of this decree and that it is in the best interest of the minor child herein that principal care and custody be awarded to Petitioner subject to right of reasonable visitation of Respondent. 7. Petitioner is not now pregnant.

8. Neither party is an active member of the Armed Forces of the United States.

9. The Court finds that the property and debt schedule entitled Exhibit A is the property and debts owned by Petitioner and Respondent and that the division thereon is not unconscionable.

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IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Court that the marriage between Annie Jean Conner and Carless Conner be dissolved.

IT IS FURTHER ONDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Principal care and custody of minor child Kristi Conner is awarded to Petitioner subject to right of reasonable visitation of Respondent and that Petitioner have judgement against Respondent in the amount of \$150.00 per month as child support, the first payment due August 29, 1986 and a like payment due the same day of each succeeding month. Respondent shall maintain medical insurance on minor child Kristi Conner.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that each party will receive the property and debts in the manner that they are set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and adopted herein by reference; and that each party will indemnify and hold the other party harmless from the debts each is to pay. Respondent assumes all marital debts other than those listed to be paid by Petitioner on Exhibit A.

IT IS FURTHER ()RDERED that Respondent pay Petitioner \$7500.00 for Petitioner's interest in Sportmen's Lodge. Upon payment of said sum Petitioner is ordered to release any interest and possession she has in said described property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Petitioner have judgement against Respondent for maintenance in the amount of One dollar a year for the next five years.
