ORDER

NATURE OF APPLICATION

A hearing was held on this matter on February 27, 1990, before the Planning Commission. Application requested a seven lot subdivision on approximately 2.02 acres. This request was reviewed per Article 46, Sections 46.003, 46.004, and 46.005 of the Land Development Code.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The property is located in a portion of Section 36 of Township 38, Range 9, being Tax Lots 800 and 900 with Tax Account number being 3809-36CC-800 and 900. The property is generally located on the west side of Patterson Street approximately 400 feet north of Shasta Way, at the intersection of Patterson Street and Sage Way.

RELEVANT FACTS

The property contains approximately 2.02 acres and is currently zoned RS (Suburban Residential) with lot sizes being 10,000 square feet plus. The staff report indicates lots in the surrounding area vary in size with the majority of the lots to the east being 10,000 square feet and lots to the east are those located in Hoyina Heights. Proposed development is for single family residential use, similar to uses in the surrounding area.

SERVICES AND FACILITIES

Access off of Patterson Street will be via a cul-de-sac approximately 200 feet plus in length. Access to each lot will be via the cul-de-sac and not Patterson Street. Sewer for subdivision will be South Suburban Sanitary District with water being provided by the City of Klamath Falls. Site is within Fire District No. 1, with fire station approximately 1.6 miles from proposed subdivision. Electricity provided by Pacific Power and Light.

RELEVANT APPROVAL CRATERIA

Refer to Klamath County Planning Department Staff Report, Exhibit A, referencing review criteria of Article 46, Sections 46.003, 46.004, and 46.005 of the Land Development: Code and Code Requirements.

FINDINGS

The Klamath County Planning Commission finds evidence submitted by applicants, Exhibit E, findings document and testimony, demonstrated that proper criteria for approval had been addressed. The Planning Commission also finds that for final plat approval, Article 46, Sections 46.003, 46.004, and 46.005 and other Code Requirements must be met as indicated on Klamath County Exhibit F.

CONCLUSIONS

This application satisfies and addresses the review criteria of Article 46, Sections 46.003, 46.004, and 46.005 of the Land Development Code.

ORDER

Therefore, the Klamath County Planning Commission approves exhibits, drainage plan, findings, code requirements and Tract 1261, The Heights, for Rochelle and Howard White.
