1.5 RESERVATION OF MINERAL RIGHTS. Mineral Rights are not being retained. Mineral Rights are being retained. - 1.9 WARRANTY DEED. Upon payment of the total purchase price for the property as provided by this Contract and performances by Buyer of all other terms, conditions, and provisions of the Contract, Seller shall deliver to Buyer a Warranty Deed. Such Warranty Deed shall warrant marketable title, except for those liens and encumbrances referred to on page 1 of this Contract and those placed upon the property or suffered by Buyer after the date of this Contract.

## SECTION 2. POSSESSION; MAINTENANCE

- 2.1 POSSESSION. Buyer shall be entitled to possession of the property from and after the date of this Contract. Buyer shall not permit the premises to be vacant for more than thirty (30) consecutive days.

- 2.3 COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS. - 3.2 APPLICATION OF PROCEEDS. All proceeds of any insurance on the property shall be held by Seller.
