## CLAIM OF LIEN

FARM LABOR, SERVICES  
MATERIALS

NOTICE HEREBY IS GIVEN That Jim Cheyne dba CHEYNE BROTHERS  
claims a lien upon the crops of Rod Lyon & Sons (kind of  
crops) potatoes and the following described animals none

raised and grown in the year 1990 upon the following described farmland,  
range, ranch, orchard land or in claimant's place of business situated in Klamath  
County, Oregon, to-wit: any and all that real property employed for the production  
of crops by the Debtor which is or will become part of that Debtor's productive  
capacity by means of ownership, rent, lease or other means of control during  
the 1990 crop year. This description is intended by its generality to include  
any and all parcels of farm ground to and into which the supplied materials may  
be directed, placed or employed by the Debtor.

Said lien also is claimed upon the proceeds of the sale of any or all of said crops and  
animals and upon the unborn progeny of said animals which are utero on the date of the  
filing of this claim of lien. For brevity, the crops and/or animals and/or their said unborn  
progeny charged with this lien hereinafter are called chattels.

Said lien is claimed for labor performed, materials supplied and/or services  
provided (as hereinafter more particularly described) by claimant at the request and for the  
benefit of the owner of said chattels to aid the growing or harvesting of crops and for the  
raising of livestock upon the land described above; the words "performs labor or provides  
services," "materials," "growing and harvesting" and "raising animals" as used in this lien  
have the meaning ascribed to them in ORS 87226(3), to which reference hereby is made.

The said labor, materials and/or services consisted of Three Thousand Six Hundred  
Fifty and One Tenth (3,650.1) Hundredweight Russet Burbank Seed Potatoes  
and transportation charges associated with delivery of same to the Debtor.

The name of the owner of the chattels so charged with this lien is: Jim Cheyne dba  
CHEYNE BROTHERS
