......as grantor, William Sisemore, as trustee, and KLAMATH FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States, as beneficiary;

WITNESSETH:

The grantor irrevocably grants, bargains, sells and conveys to the trustee, in trust, with power of sale, the property in . Klamath . County, Oregon, described as:

Grantor's performance under this trust deed and the note it secures may not be assigned to or be assumed by another party. In the event of an attempted assignment or assumption, the entire unpaid balance may become immediately due and payable. which said described real property is not currently used for agricultural, timber or grazing purposes,

together with all and singular the appartenances, tenements, hereditaments, rents, issues, profits, water rights, easements or privileges now or hereafter belonging to, derived from or in enywise appertaining to the above described premises, and all plumbing, lighting, heating, ventilating, air-conditioning, retrigerating, watering and irrigation apparatus, equipment and fixtures, together with all awnings, venetian blinds, floor covering in place such as well-to-well carpeting and lineleum, shades and built-in appliances now or hereafter installed in or used in connection

This trust deed shall further secure the payment of such additional money, if any, as may be loaned hereafter by the beneficiary to the grantor or others having an interest in the above described property, as may be evidenced by a note or notes. If the indebtedness secured by this trust deed is evidenced by more than one note, the beneficiary may credit payments received by it upon any of said-notes or part of any payment on one note and part on another, as the beneficiary may glect.

The grantor ore by covenants to end with the trustee and the beneficiary rein that the said premises and property conveyed by this trust deed are and clear of all encumbrances and that the grantor will and his heirs, centors and administrators shall warrant and defend his said title thereto ainst the claims of all persons whomsoever.

The granace constraints and agrees to pay said note according to the termsthereof and, when due, all taxes, assessments and other charges levied against asid property; to keep said property free from all encumbrances having precedence over this trust deed; to complete all buildings in course of construction or hereafter constructed on said premises within six months from the date hereof or the date construction is hereafter commenced; to repair and restore promptly and in good workmanlike manner any building or improvement on said property which may be damaged or destroyed and pay, when due, all construction; to replace any work or materials unsatisfactory to beneficiary within fifteen days after written notice from beneficiary of the beneficiary of inspect said promises; to keep all buildings and improvements now or hareafter erected upon said property in good repair and to commit or suffer no waste of said premises; to keep all buildings, property and improvements now or hereafter erected on said promises continuously insured against loss by fire or such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in a sum not less than the original principal sum of the note or obligation secured by this trust deed, in a company or companies acceptable to the beneficiary, and to deliver the original policy of insurance in correct form and with approved loss payable clause in favor of the beneficiary may in its own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary may in its own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary may in its own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary may in its own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary may in its own discretion obtain insurance for the beneficiary defendence shall be non-cancellable by the grantor during the full term of the policy thus obtained.

In order to provide regularly for the prompt payment of said taxes, assessments or other charges and insurance premiums, the granter agrees to pay to the beneficiary, together with and in addition to the monthly payments of principal and interest payable under the terms of the note or obligation accured hereby, an amount equal to one-twelfth (1/12th) of the taxes, assessments and other charges due and payable with respect to said property within each succeeding twelve months, and also one-thirty-sixth (1/36th) of the insurance premiums payable with respect to said property within each succeeding three years while this trust deed remains in effect, as estimated and directed by the beneficiary, such sums to be credited to the principal of the loan until required for the several purposes thereof and shall thereupon be charged to the principal of the loan; or, at the option of the beneficiary, the sums so paid shall be held by the beneficiary in trust as a reserve account, without interest, to pay said premiums, taxes, assessments or other charges when they shall become due and payable.

While the grantor is to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or assessed against said property, or any part thereof, before the same begin to bear interest and also to pay premiums on all insurance policies upon said property, such payments are to be made through the beneficiary, as a aforesaid. The grantor hereby authorizes the beneficiary to pay any and all taxes, assessments and other charges levied or imposed against said property in the amounts as shown by the statements thereof turnished by the collector of, such taxes, assessments or other charges, and to pay the insurance premiums in the amounts shown on the statements submitted by the insurance carriers or their representatives, and to charge said sums to the principal of the loan or to withdraw the sums which may be required from the reserve account, if, any, established for that purpose. The grantor agrees in no event to hold the beneficiary responsible for failure to have any insurance written or, for any, loss or damage growing out of a defect in any such insurance; policy, and the beneficiary hereby is authorized, in the event of any such insurance receipts upon the obligations secured by this trust deed. In full or upon sale or other acquisition of the property by the beneficiary after

default, any balance remaining in the reserve account shall be credited to the indebtedness. If the reserve account for taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges is not sufficient at any time for the payment of such charges as they become due, the grantor shall pay the deficit to the beneficiary upon demand, and if not paid within ten days after such demand, the beneficiary may at its option add the amount of such deficit to the principal of the obligation secured hereby.

Should the grantor fail to keep any of the foregoing covenants, then the heneficiary may at its option carry out the same, and all its expenditures therefor shall draw interest at the rate specified in the note, shall be repayable by the grantor on demand and shall be secured by the lien of this trust deed. In this connection, the beneficiary shall have the right in its discretion to complete any improvements made on said premises and also to make such repairs to said property as in its sole discretion it may deem necessary or advisable.

The grantor further agrees to comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; to pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust, including the cost of title search, as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred in connection with or in enforcing this obligation, and trustee's and attorney's fees actually incurred; to appear in, and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security hereof or the rights or powers of the beneficiary or trustee; and to pay all costs and expenses, including cost of evidence of title and attorney's fees in a reasonable sum to be fixed by the court, in any such action or proceeding In which the beneficiary or trustee may appear and in any suit brought by beneficiary to foreclose this deed, and all said sums shall be secured by this trust deed.

The beneficiary will furnish to the grantor on written request therefor an annual statement of account but shall not be obligated or required to furnish any further statements of account.

It is mutually agreed that:

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It in the event that any portion or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, the beneficiary shall have the right to commence, prosecute in its own name, appear in or defend any action or proceedings, or to make any compromise or settlement in connection with such taking and, if it so elects to require that all or any portion of the money's payable as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by the grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to the beneficiary and applied by it first upon any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees necessarily paid or incurred by the heneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance applied upon the indebtedness secured hereby; and the grantor agrees, make the proceedings of take such actions and execute such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon the beneficiary's request.

At any time and from time to time upon written request of the beneficiary, payment of its fees and presentation of this deed and the note for endorsement (in case of full reconveyance, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, the trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in granting any easement or creating and restriction thereon, (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this deed or the lien or charge hereof; (d) reconvey, without warranty, all or any part of the property. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto" and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness in the same of the services in this paragraph shall be to the property of the property affected by this deed and of any personal property located thereon. (2) To the obligation secured by the trust deed. (3) To all persons having recorded liens subsequent to the interests of the trustee in the trust deed as their interests appear in the order of their, priority. (4) The Jumplus, It any, to the grantor of the trust deed or to his successor in interest entitled to such surplus.
- 10. For any reason permitted by law, the beneficiary may from time to time appoint a successor or successors to any trustee named herein, or to an successor rustee appointed hereunder. Upon such appointment and without conveyance to the successor trustee, the latter shall be vested with all title, power and duties conferred upon any trustee herein named or appointed hereunder. Each such appointment and substitution shall be made by written instrument execute by the beneficiary, containing reference to this trust deed and its place or record, which, when recorded in the office of the county or counties in which the property is situated, shall be conclusive proof o proper appointment of the successor trustee.

The term "beneficiary" shall mean the holder and owner, including pledgee, of the note secured hereby, whether or not named as a beneficiary herein.
