


LAST WILL AND TESTAMENTOFMELVIN J. PAGANO

I, MELVIN J. PAGANO, residing in the City of Mountain View, County of Santa Clara, State of California, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do hereby revoke any and all Wills and Codicils heretofore made by me, and do make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament.

FIRST: I declare that I was married to ALICE L. PAGANO and that said marriage was dissolved by divorce and that there were four (4) children the issue of said marriage, to-wit: GARY, DAVID, MELVIN and JOSEPH PAGANO, and no deceased issue.

SECOND: I direct that all my debts, funeral expenses and cost of administration be paid out of the principal of my estate.

THIRD: I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my four (4) sons, share and share alike, all of the property of all kinds wherever situated, whether real, personal or mixed, belonging to me at the time of my death, and in the event that any of my sons shall predecease me, his share shall pass unto his surviving issue, if any, and if any son shall predecease me and shall fail to leave surviving issue then his share shall be divided equally among his surviving brothers.

FOURTH: I hereby nominate and appoint JAMES B. O'GRADY, Attorney at Law, the Executor of this, my Last Will and Testament, and further direct that he shall not be required to furnish bond.

I authorize my aforesaid Executor to sell, at either public or private sale, any property belonging to my estate, either with or without notice, subject to such confirmation as may be required by law, and to hold, manage and operate any such property.

FIFTH: If any person, whether or not related in any way by blood to me, shall either directly or indirectly attempt to oppose or set aside the probate of this, my Last Will and Testament, or to impair, invalidate or set aside or declare void any of the provisions hereof, and such person shall establish a right to any part of my estate, I give and bequeath to such person the sum of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) only, and no further interest whatsoever in my estate.
