Shots & worming = to maintain health.

Hoof care

Feed: hay, grain, salt, minerals, & vitamins.

(Skip's weight was very low, it has taken a lot to bring him up where he should be. He is stunted in size because of improper care in the past. This is confirmed from my Vet.)

Vet. care = Just after Scott brought him over he got colic. The vet said it was due to worms & he wasn't used to being fed so well.

(When we picked him up he had been tied out without much grass and when we had stopped by before he had no water or grass.) The colic was mostly due to having worms very badly from not being dewormed.

I have been the only one to take care of Skip, feeding, brushing, training, cutting out sheep, etc.

On the back is our cost of supplies & labor.

He has been at my place going on 27 weeks.

Scott agrees with my billing. I have explained it to him.

My bill to date 12-3-90 is \$530.50

All continues daily. We have spoke with

Scott several times on this. I am asking
