Subject as to the rights of other parties with respect to any of said lands under instruments of record and existing agreements with and permits from Owner.


The terms and conditions of this Telephone Line Right-of-Way Easement are as follows:

- 3. All buried telephone cable is to be buried at a minimum depth of thirty (30) inches. The location of said cable is to be clearly marked by the placement of intervisible markers.
- 4. Grantee expressly waives any and all claims against Owner for damage to its equipment or facilities arising out of Owner's normal logging operations on the land described herein. Owner shall give reasonable notice to Grantee of said operations in order that Grantee may have men and equipment available to protect or repair said equipment or facilities
- Grantee shall pay for all damages to Owner's property resulting directly or indirectly from the negligent acts or omissions of Grantee hereunder.
- Grantee shall indemnify and hold harmless Owner from all claims for damages which may be caused by Grantee's exercise of rights herein granted.
- In the event of abandonment of said facilities and necessary appurtenances by Grantee for a continuous period of three (3) years, all rights granted herein shall terminate.

This Telephone Line Right-of-Way Easement is granted pursuant to that Right of Entry and Authorization dated April 6, 1990 by virtue of which Grantee has

constructed its facilities under and upon Owner's real property described above. In consideration of the rights herein granted, Grantee hereby abandons and releases to Owner all rights granted in said Right of Entry and Authorization.
