9. At any time and from time to time upon written request of beneficiary, payment of its lees and presentation of this deed and the note lor endorsement (in case of lut reconveyances for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plat of said property; (b) join in
