

SATISFACTION OF CONSTRUCTION LIEN

The Claimant does hereby represent that the Claim of Construction Lien has been paid and the lien be of no further force and effect and be otherwise hereby discharged.

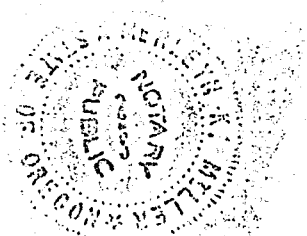
