KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Michael B. Jager and Margaret H. Jager, husband and wife and Clark J. Kenyon, a married man hereinafter called the grantor, for the consideration hereinafter stated, to grantor paid by Larry D. Burg and Marie K. Burg, husband and wife, hereinafter called the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 3 in Block 4 in Tract 1039.

To Have and to Hold the same unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns forever.

And said grantor hereby covenants to and with said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, that grantor is lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises, free from all encumbrances except contracts, liens, assessments, rules and regulations for irrigation, drainage and sewage, and reservations, restrictions, easements, and rights of way of record and those apparent on the land.

And that grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.

The true and actual consideration paid for this transfer, stated in terms of dollars, is \$ 2,000.00.
