AMENDED CLAIM OF LIEN

Contributions to Employee
Benefit Plan

KNOW ALL MEN BY THIS NOTICE, that the Trustees of the Oregon Teamster Employers Trust, or the successors thereof, through their administrative agent, claim a lien for employee benefit contributions due the aforesaid Trust Fund pursuant to the provisions of ORS 87,.85 et seq., on the "earnings and on all property used in the operation of the employer's business," described more particularly as follows:

D. Description of Employer's Property:

All real estate, and personal property, including trucks, equipment and office supplies.

1. At the special instance and request of the employees of Beaver Bread, Inc., whether union or non-union, as defined in and covered by the labor agreement in effect at the time of the employee's work, between Teamsters Local 962, and the employees who performed labor for or on behalf of the above employer in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon. The real property used in the operation of the employer's business is more particularly described as follows:

2. As a result of the employment with the employer in the above-described business during the months of November and December, 1990, contributions became due to the aforesaid Trust Funds on December 15, 1990 and January 15, 1991 respectively.

3. The following is a true statement of the Trustee's

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demand after deducting all just credits and offsets:

Calculation of Demand: $(2 \times \$1286.00 = \$2573.00)$

Contributions of: \$2573.80

Liquidated Damages: \$514.76

Filing Costs: \$15.00

Total Demand: \$3,103.56

4. The Trustees of the aforesaid Trust Fund claim a lien for a total amount of \$3,103.56 as listed above, upon: The earnings and all property used in the operations of the above-described employer's business. This lien is claimed by the Trustees of the Trust Fund pursuant to their authority conferred on them by the Trust Agreements, as amended, establishing the Trust Funds, in order to compel the Employer to pay Employee Benefit Contributions to the Trust Fund as required by the terms of the Labor Agreements.

5. The statutory time in which the Trustees have to make and file this amended claim of lien pursuant to ORS 87.860 with the Clerk of Klamath County in which said employees were employed by said Employer has not yet expired.

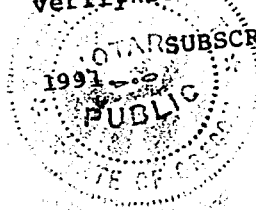
