The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereof." and the recitals therein of any matters or lacts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee's lees for any of the services mentioned in this paragraph shall be not less than \$5.

10. Upon any default by grantor hereunder, beneficiary may at any time without notice, either in person, by agent or by a receiver to be appointed by a court, and without regard to the adequacy of any security for the indebtedness hereby secured, enter upon and take possession of said property or any part thereof, in its own name suo or otherwise collect the rents, issues and profits, including those past due and unpaid, and apply the same, less costs and expenses of operation and collection, including reasonable attorney's less upon any indebtedness secured hereby, and in such order as beneficiary may determine.

## EXHIBIT "A" LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The following described real property situate in Klamath County, Oregon;

Lots 10, 11 and 12 and that portion of Lot 13 in Section 9, Township 33 South, Range 7 1/2 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 13 of Section 9, Township 33 South, Range 7 1/2 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence South 0 degrees 20' West along the West line of said Lot 13, 729.30 feet to the center line of the Wood River Ditch; thence North 37 degrees 37' East along said centerline, 914.76 feet, to the North line of said Lot 13; thence South 89 degrees 46' West along the North line of Lot 13, 559.68 feet to the point of beginning.
