

TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

THIS TERMINATION OF EASEMENT, dated this 15th day of April, 1991, by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture,

WHEREAS, W.R. Campbell and Eva D. Campbell granted to the United States of America an easement for a telephone line, dated February 29, 1932, and recorded on March 2, 1932, as Instrument No. 19842 in Book 74, at page 68, County of Lake, State of Oregon, over and across the following described premises:

- T. 36 S., R. 15 E., W.M.
 - sec. 19, N1/2S1/2
 - sec. 20, NE1/4SW1/4
 - sec. 21, NW1/4SW1/4, S1/2
- T. 36 S., R. 14 E., W.M.
 - sec. 24, NE1/4SW1/4, W1/2SW1/4, N1/2SE1/4

which easement contained the following provisions:

" This grant shall be effective so long as said easement shall be actually used for the purposes above specified but all rights hereunder shall revert to the owner of the land as soon as the said use thereof shall be abandoned and discontinued."



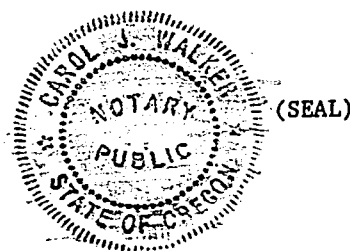
