

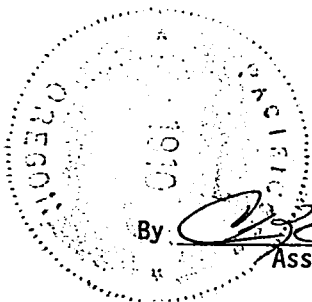
QUITCLAIM DEED

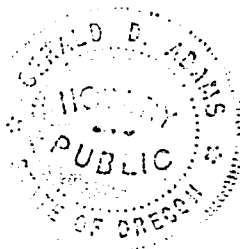
