I assumed he was running from me and it was my grandsons bike - I went into Giegler's Park and saw the boy riding between Tractors on the blue bike. At this point a fellow from the Corner Carolot saw all this and tried to help me find the boy. He found the big bike, the man suggested I take it home and call the police. Meanwhile - my brother was dropping off his sister-in-law at the Trailer Park. I told him what had happened - so he said he'd see if he could find the boy - He did find the boy and the boy told him - he thought I was his neighbors divorced "crazy" wife. Also he was taking his neighbors blue bike to fill a flat tire - My brother told him to follow him as he knew where the bike was, the boy followed him for about a half block and took off down an alley - I called 911 - the sheriff's deputy arrived and took the information and suggested I file claim Theresa J.
