- There is a 20 foot alley for a further buffer.
- In review of the site and plot plan the area for addition
- is the only area for development.

 E. The granting of this variance will not be detrimental to the public health, safety and welfare or to the use and joyment of adjacent properties.

Therefore based upon the above findings and conclusions the report of file VAR 4-91, Planning Director will grant approval of request for a rear yard setback of 10 feet in order for addition onto existing church.
