KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

, hereinafter called the grantee, does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said grantee and grantee's heirs, successors and assigns, the certain real property, with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining, situated in the County of Klamath and State of Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 8, 9, and 11, Block 3, INDUSTRIAL ADDITION to the City of Klamath Falls, according to the official plat thereof on file in the office of the County Clerk of Klamath County, Oregon.

SUBJECT TO: Real Estate Contract, dated June 5, 1981, of which a Memorandum was recorded June 5, 1981 in Volume M81, page 10117, Microfilm Records of Klamath County, Oregon, in favor of Leonard L. Fike and Joyce L. Fike, husband and wife, as Vendors, which the above described Grantees agrees to assume and pay in full.

"This instrument will not allow use of the property described in this instrument in violation of applicable land use laws and regulations. grantor will warrant and forever defend the said premises and every part and parcel thereof against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever, except those claiming under the above described encumbrances.
