A. Nature, extent, and cost of the survey.

The nature of this geophysical survey was an examination of claim areas for relative isotopic readings of radioactive AU. The examination is of value not only for qualitative indications, but also for quantitative comparisons of one area of the deposit to another. The instrument is of the Algor scintillometer type and has been used extensively to find and evaluate mineral properties. The cost of the survey is indicated on the affidavit of proof of labor.

B. Location of the work performed.
