CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT CUP 41-91

This matter came before Neil D. Smith, Hearings Officer for Klamath County, Oregon on 12 July 1991 in the County Commissioners' Meeting Room in Klamath Falls Oregon. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Mr. Kim Lundahl the recording secretary was Ms. Karen Burg. The Klamath County Planning Department file and all the exhibits and other contents therein is incorporated by this reference into this matter.

The Hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related Statutes and Ordinances. The applicant for the above referenced Conditional Use Permit, was present and testified. Witnesses information was received and found to be in favor of the permit. Except for the State Highway Department who expressed concern regarding ingress and egress from State highway 97. This caused the matter to be continued pending resolution of the access problem. 14 January 1992 the planning department received a letter from a Reiley Smith of tha Oregon Department of Transportation, that letter states that the problem they expressed in their earlier letter was resolved.
