ORDER CONVERTING A CHAPTER 11
CASE TO A CASE UNDER CHAPTER 7
AND APPOINTING A TRUSTEE

Debtor.

Relief was ordered for the above-named debtor under Chapter 11 of 11 U.S.C., and it appearing this case should be converted to a liquidation case;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this case is converted to a liquidation case under Chapter 7 of Title 11 of the United States Code.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Richard Gervais is designated, pursuant to Rule 9001(5) of the Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, to perform the duties imposed upon the debtor and the debtor-in-possession by Title 11 of the United States Code, including § 521, and by Rules 1007 and 1019 of the Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure.

ORDER OF CONVERSION--1

1 2. The debtor, or trustee if one has been appointed by the
2 court, SHALL FILE WITH THE CLERK'S OFFICE, WITHIN 15 DAYS, IN
3 TRIPLICATE: a final report and account (pursuant to Bankruptcy
4 Rule 1019) by fully completing Local Form #1111 with the estate
5 information from the filing date to this date of conversion, a
6 SEPARATE list of the names and complete mailing addresses of, AND
7 (per local form #104) a SEPARATE Master Mailing Matrix for all
8 creditors whose debts remain unpaid and were incurred AFTER the
9 filing of the Chapter 11 petition AND BEFORE this date of
10 conversion, the appropriate Chapter 7 Statement of Affairs,
11 complete A and B schedules listing all creditors and interested
12 parties (including complete mailing addresses for each) and
13 property of the debtor as of this date of conversion to Chapter 7,
14 Exhibit C (Current Income and Expenses); PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that
15 these requirements shall be waived (EXCEPT FOR the need to file a
16 matrix as specified above and comply with any applicable provisions
17 of 11 U.S.C. § 521) upon the filing of a declaration under penalty
18 of perjury by the debtor within the above specified time
19 requirement stating that the Schedules of Assets and Liabilities,
20 Statement of Affairs and, if applicable, any amendments thereto
21 previously filed in conjunction with the Chapter 11 case,
22 substantially reflect the condition of the debtor and the estate at
23 the time of conversion, AND THE FILING of a certification that
24 copies of the declaration and copies of all the Schedules and
25 Statements and amendments thereto were served on the trustee named
26 below.

ORDER OF CONVERSION-2

3. (If the debtor fails to comply with paragraph 2 above) THE DEBTOR SHALL APPEAR BEFORE THE COURT AT 1:30 o'clock p.m. on September 5, 1991, in Bankruptcy Courtroom #429, United States Federal Building, 211 East 7th Avenue, Eugene, Oregon, and explain the reasons, if any, for your failure to obey a lawful court order as set forth in paragraph 2 above. If you do not adequately explain your failure to obey, the court may (1) order a third person to perform the above duties and enter a judgment against you to pay such person reasonable compensation for the services performed and other reasonable costs; (2) dismiss this case; or (3) order such other relief as the court may deem appropriate.

4. An estate (the "Estate") be and hereby is created. All property of the debtor be and hereby is vested in the Estate pursuant to § 541 of the Code applied as if the debtor filed a Chapter 7 petition on the date of entry of this order. For all purposes except the purpose described in this paragraph, the date of filing of the petition shall remain the original filing date of the petition initiating this case.

5. The automatic stay of § 362(a) of the Code be and hereby is reimposed.

6. Except as expressly provided herein, this case shall be governed by § 348 of the Code.
