

TERMINATION OF EASEMENT

THIS TERMINATION OF EASEMENT dated this 12th day of May, 1992, by the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, acting by and through the Forest Service, Department of Agriculture.

WHEREAS, Gilchrist Timber Company granted to the United States of America a temporary easement for an unnamed spur road, dated March 13, 1972, and recorded on March 16, 1972, in Book M72, at page 2840, County of Klamath, State of Oregon, over and across the following described premises:

which easement contained the following provisions:

"This grants shall continue as long as needed for the above purposes, and shall expire upon completion of the above work, or on January 1, 1978, whichever occurs first."

NOW THEREFORE, this TERMINATION OF EASEMENT is executed for the purpose of showing that it has been determined that the United States of America has no further need for the easement and that the easement pursuant to its provisions has ceased and terminated and is hereby cancelled.
