CONSENT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, PACIFICORP, doing business as PACIFIC POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, an Oregon corporation, successor in interest to the California Oregon Power Company, hereinafter called the "Consentor," by virtue of two easements for rights of way for pole and tower and wire lines and other facilities for the transmission and distribution of electricity, one dated December 21, 1954, and recorded February 2, 1955, in Volume 272, page 111, and the second dated April 25, 1955, and recorded May 2, 1955, in Volume 274, page 99, both in Klamath County records, has an interest in the following described real property situated in Klamath County, State of Oregon, to wit:

WHEREAS, the STATE OF OREGON, acting by and through its Parks and Recreation Department, Successor in interest to the State of Oregon, by and through its State Highway Commission as per O.R.S. 390.111 Subsection (2), has conveyed to the United States of America, an easement for right-of-way purposes over and across said real property by virtue of instrument dated May 30, 1991, and recorded June 25, 1991, in Volume M91, page 12130, Klamath County Records.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof are Exhibits A and B depicting the approximate location of facilities described herein.

WHEREAS, the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, by and through the Forest Service, Winema National Forest, acknowledges Consentor's title to said two easements for rights-of-way for pole and tower and wire lines and the priority of Consentor's title therein and agrees never to resist or assail the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, Consentor consents to the above mentioned conveyance from the State of Oregon to the United States upon the real property hereinbefore described.

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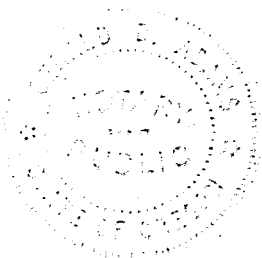

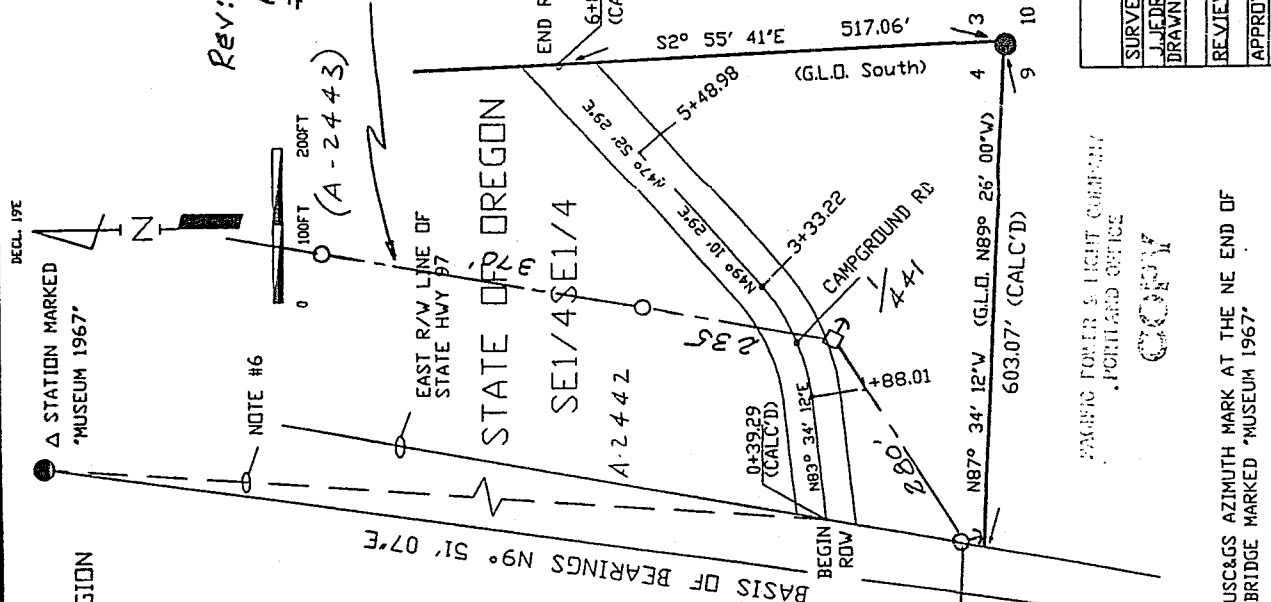

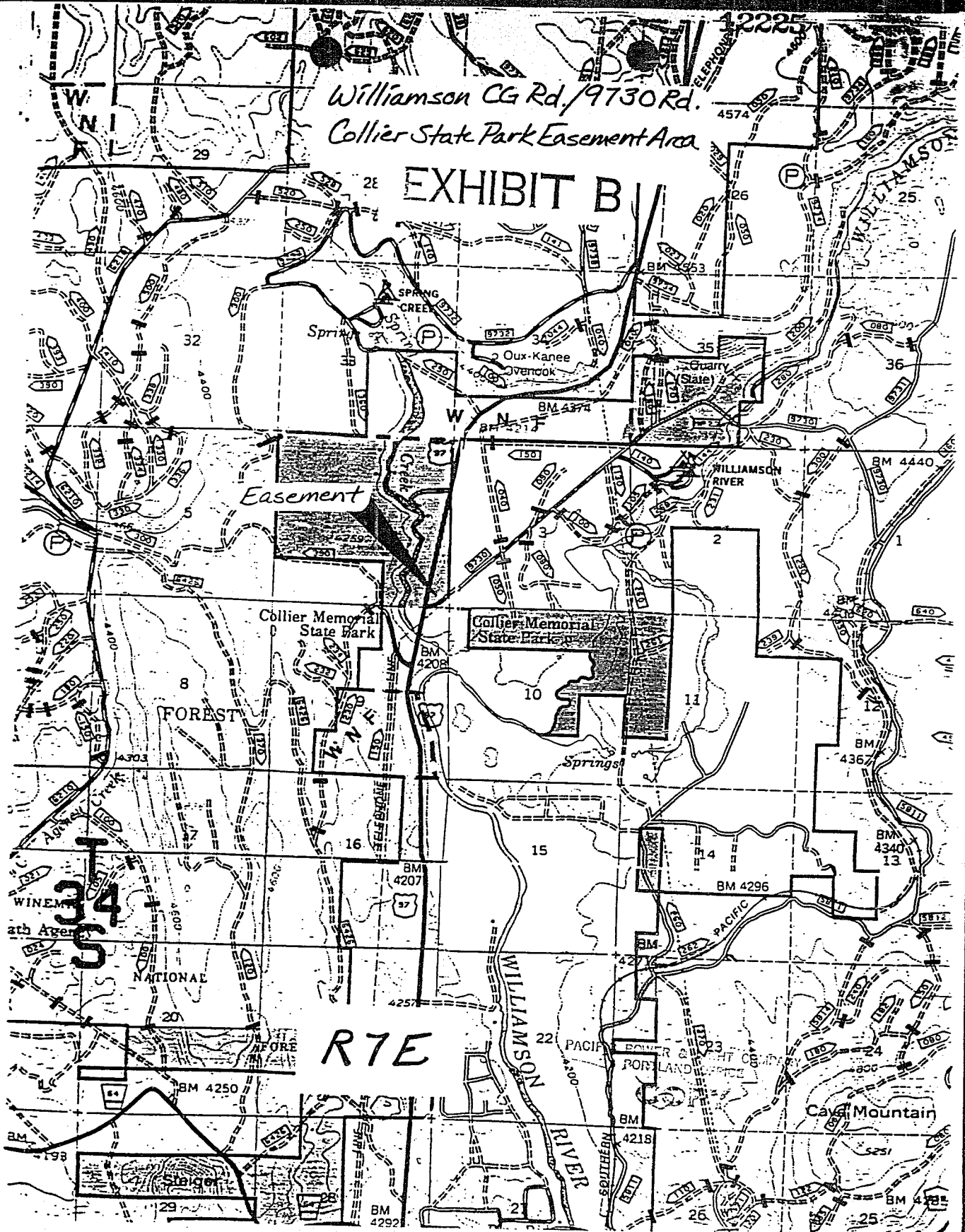


CORNER MONUMENTS FOUND
