## TRUST DEED

THIS TRUST DEED, made this 1st day of July, 1992, between  
ROBERT U. BURCH,

as Grantor, MOUNTAIN TITLE COMPANY OF Klamath County, as Trustee, and  
BARBARA N. PENNY, GARY R. PENNY, PATRICK J. PENNY, & THOMAS A. PELLEWESSEL,  
WITH RIGHTS OF SURVIVORSHIP,  
as Beneficiary.

## WITNESSETH:

Grantor irrevocably grants, bargains, sells and conveys to trustee in trust, with power of sale, the property in Klamath County, Oregon, described as:

That portion of Lot 29, Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 30 feet North and 992.5 feet East of the Southwest corner of Lot 29, Section 14, Township 36 South, Range 12 East of the Willamette Meridian, Klamath County, Oregon; thence East on a line parallel with the South line of the said Lot 29, 209 feet; thence North 209 feet; thence West 209 feet; thence South 209 feet to the place of beginning.

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances and all other rights thereunto belonging or in anywise now or hereafter apportioning, and the rents, issues and profits thereof and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with said real estate.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING PERFORMANCE of each agreement of grantor herein contained and payment of the sum of Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Six and 68/100

Dollars, with interest thereon according to the terms of a promissory note of even date herewith, payable to beneficiary or order and made by grantor, the final payment of principal and interest hereof, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable per terms on note.

The date of maturity of the debt secured by this instrument is the date, stated above, on which the final installment of said note becomes due and payable.

To protect the security of this trust deed, grantor agrees:

1. To protect, preserve and maintain said property in good condition and repair; not to remove or demolish any building or improvement thereon; not to commit or permit any waste of said property.

2. To complete or restore promptly and in good and workmanlike manner any building or improvement which may be constructed, damaged or destroyed thereon, and pay when due all costs incurred therewith.

3. To comply with all laws, ordinances, regulations, covenants, conditions and restrictions affecting said property; if the beneficiary so requires, upon executing such financing statements pursuant to the Uniform Commercial Code as the beneficiary may require and to get for filing same in the proper public office or offices, as well as the cost of all such searches made by filing officers or searching agencies as may be deemed desirable by the beneficiary.

4. To provide and continuously maintain in usage on the building and/or hereafter erected on the said premises against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as the beneficiary may from time to time require, in an amount not less than \$10,000.00, written in companies acceptable to the beneficiary; with loss payable to the latter; all policies of insurance shall be delivered to the beneficiary as soon as insured if the grantor shall fail for any reason to procure a/w such insurance and to deliver same policies to the beneficiary of least fifteen days prior to the expiration of any policy of insurance now or hereafter placed on said building; the beneficiary may procure the same at grantor's expense. The amount collected under any fire or other insurance policy may be applied by the beneficiary upon any indebtedness secured hereby and in such order as beneficiary may determine, or at option of beneficiary the entire amount so collected, or any part thereof, may be released to grantor. Such application or release shall not cause or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

5. To keep said premises free from construction debris and to pay all taxes, assessments and other charges that may be levied or assessed upon or against said property before any part of such taxes, assessments and other charges become past due or delinquent and promptly deliver receipts therefor to beneficiary; should the grantor fail to make payment of any taxes, assessments, insurance premiums, liens, or other charges, payable by grantor, either by direct payment or by providing beneficiary with funds with which to make such payment, beneficiary may, at its option, make payment thereof and the amount so paid with interest at the rate of 1% forth in this note secured hereby, together with all the obligations described in paragraphs 6 and 7 of this trust deed, shall be added to and become a part of the debt secured by this trust deed, without waiver of any rights arising from breach of any of the covenants herein set forth and for such payments, with interest or otherwise, the grantor, the beneficiary described, as well as the grantor, shall be bound to the same extent that they are bound for the payment of the obligation herein described, and all such payments shall be immediately due and payable with notice, and the nonpayment thereof shall, at the option of the beneficiary, render all sums secured by this trust deed immediately due and payable and constitute a breach of this trust deed.

6. To pay all costs, fees and expenses of this trust including the cost of title search as well as the other costs and expenses of the trustee incurred in connection with or in enforcing this obligation, and trustee's and attorney's fees actually incurred.

7. To appear in and defend any action or proceeding purporting to affect the security rights or powers of beneficiary in trustee and in any suit, action or proceeding in which the beneficiary or trustee may appear, including any suit for the foreclosure of this deed, to pay all costs and expenses including evidence of title and the attorney's fees of trustee, attorney's fees, including attorney's fees mentioned in this paragraph, in all cases shall be paid by the grantor and in the event of an appeal from any judgment rendered by the trial court, grantor further agrees to pay such sum as the appellate court shall adjudge reasonable as the beneficiary's or trustee's attorney's fees on such appeal.

It is mutually agreed that:

8. In the event that any action or all of said property shall be taken under the right of eminent domain or condemnation, beneficiary shall have the right, if it so elects, to require that all or any portion of the money paid be used as compensation for such taking, which are in excess of the amount required to pay all reasonable costs, expenses and attorney's fees necessary and incurred by grantor in such proceedings, shall be paid to beneficiary and retained by it first up to any reasonable costs and expenses and attorney's fees incurred by the beneficiary in such proceedings, and the balance so paid over the indebtedness secured hereby, and grantor agrees, at its own expense, to take such actions and execute such instruments as shall be necessary in obtaining such compensation, promptly upon beneficiary's request.

9. At any time and from time to time upon written request of beneficiary, payment of its fees and compensation of this deed and the note for endorsement (in case of full reconveyance, for cancellation), without affecting the liability of any person for the payment of the indebtedness, trustee may (a) consent to the making of any map or plan of said property; (b) join in

granting any easement or creating any restriction thereon; (c) join in any subordination or other agreement affecting this deed or the lien or charge thereon; (d) re-convey, without warranty, all or any part of the property. The grantee in any reconveyance may be described as the "person or persons legally entitled thereto," and the recitals therein of any matters or facts shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Trustee's fees for any of the services mentioned in this paragraph shall not be less than \$5.

10. Upon any default by grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby, either in performance of any agreement hereunder, time being of the essence with respect to such payment and/or performance, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable, to sue an event the beneficiary at his election may proceed to foreclose this trust deed in equity as a mortgage or direct the trustee to foreclose this trust deed by advertisement and sale, or may direct the trustee to pursue any other right or remedy, either at law or in equity, which the beneficiary may have. In the event the beneficiary elects to foreclose by advertisement and sale, the beneficiary or the trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his election to sell the said described real estate, to satisfy the obligation secured hereby whereupon the trustee shall fix in the time and place of sale, give notices thereof as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.753 to 86.795.

11. The entering upon and taking possession of said property, the collection of such rents, issues and profits, or the proceeds of fire and other insurance policies or compensation or awards for any taking or damage of the property, and the application or release thereof as aforesaid, shall not cure or waive any default or notice of default hereunder or invalidate any act done pursuant to such notice.

12. Upon default by grantor in payment of any indebtedness secured hereby, in his performance of any agreement hereunder, time being of the essence with respect to such payment and/or performance, the beneficiary may declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable, to sue an event the beneficiary at his election may proceed to foreclose this trust deed by advertisement and sale, or may direct the trustee to pursue any other right or remedy, either at law or in equity, which the beneficiary may have. In the event the beneficiary elects to foreclose by advertisement and sale, the beneficiary or the trustee shall execute and cause to be recorded his written notice of default and his election to sell the said described real estate, to satisfy the obligation secured hereby whereupon the trustee shall fix in the time and place of sale, give notices thereof as then required by law and proceed to foreclose this trust deed in the manner provided in ORS 86.753 to 86.795.

13. After the trustee has commenced foreclosure by advertisement and sale, and at any time prior to 5 days before the date the trustee conducts the sale, the grantor or any other person so privileged by ORS 86.753, may cure the default or defaults. If the default consists of a failure to pay, when due, sums secured by this trust deed, the default may be cured by paying the entire amount due at the time of the cure other than such portion as would have been cured had no default occurred. Any other default that is capable of being cured may be cured by tendering the performance required under the obligation or trust deed. In any case, in addition to curing the default or defaults, the person effecting the cure shall pay to the beneficiary all costs and expenses actually incurred in enforcing the obligation of the trust deed together with trustee's and attorney's fees not exceeding the amounts provided in the manner provided in ORS 86.753 to 86.795.

14. Otherwise, the sale shall be held on the date and at the time and place designated in the notice of sale or the time to which said sale may be postponed as provided by law. The trustee may sell said property either in one parcel or in separate parcels and shall sell the parcel or parcels at auction to the highest bidder for cash, payable at the time of sale. Trustee shall deliver to the purchaser its deed in form as required by law conveying the property so sold, but without any covenant or warranty, express or implied. The recitals in the deed of any matter of fact shall be conclusive proof of the truthfulness thereof. Any person participating in the sale, including the grantor and beneficiary, may purchase at the sale.

15. When trustee sells pursuant to the powers provided herein, trustee shall apply the proceeds of sale to payment of (1) the expenses of sale, including the compensation of the trustee and a reasonable charge by trustee's attorney, (2) to the obligation secured by the trust deed, (3) to all persons having record title subsequent to the interest of the trustee in the trust deed as their interests may appear in the order of their priority, and (4) the surplus.

16. Beneficiary may from time to time appoint a successor or successors to any trustee named herein or to any successor trustee appointed hereunder. Upon such appointment, and without conveyance to the successor trustee, the latter shall be vested with all title, powers and duties conferred upon any trustee herein named or appointed hereunder. Each such appointment and substitution shall be made by written instrument executed by beneficiary, which, when recorded in the mortgage records of the county or counties in which the property is situated, shall be conclusive proof of proper appointment of the successor trustee.

17. Trustee accepts this deed when this deed, duly executed and acknowledged is made a public record as provided by law. Trustee is not obligated to notify any party hereto of pending sale under any other deed of trust or of any action or proceeding in which grantor, beneficiary or trustee shall be a party unless such action or proceeding is brought by trustee.

NOTE: The Trust Deed Act provides that the trust hereunder must be either an attorney, who is an active member of the Oregon State Bar, a bank, trust company or savings and loan association authorized to do business under the laws of Oregon or the United States, a title insurance company authorized to insure title to real property of this state, its subsidiaries, affiliates, agents or branches, the United States or any agency thereof, or an escrow agent licensed under ORS 696.505 to 696.595.


