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2. The Defendant, GARY BEAUCHAMP, is adjudged to be the legal father of the minor children, REBECCA BEAUCHAMP, DOB: NOVEMBER 11, 1978, ELIZABETH BEAUCHAMP, DOB: OCTOBER 3, 1980, and VINCENT BEAUCHAMP, DOB: NOVEMBER 27, 1983, and shall pay support for said minor children in the amount of \$663.00 per month for child support commencing SEPTEMBER 1, 1990 and continuing each month thereafter until further order of the court or until the child marries, dies, is emancipated, reaches 19, or reaches 18 and is not a full time high school student, whichever occurs first;

- 3. That Defendant shall pay the sum of \$8,500.89 as and for reimbursement of public assistance for the period of AUGUST 24, 1989 through AUGUST 31, 1990, to the Plaintiff, the County of Amador; said reimbursement to be paid at the rate of \$75.00 per month commencing APRIL 1, 1992 and continuing on or before the first day of each and every month until paid in full. THIS IS NOT AN INSTALLMENT JUDGMENT. The entire sum is presently due and payable, with this payment schedule only and solely for the convenience of the Defendant. This payment schedule does not prohibit the Plaintiff from exercising any method of enforcement or collection at any time. Interest is applied on the declining balance;
- 4. All payments for child support and welfare reimbursement shall be paid to Amador County Family Support Division, 108 Court Street, Jackson, California 95642;
- 5. Defendant shall provide medical, dental and vision insurance coverage for said minor children when available through his employer when available at a reasonable cost and provide proof of same to the Family Support Division;

DATED:

- 6. Defendant shall provide the District Attorney, Family Support Division, with all necessary documentation for insurance coverage for said minor children in the way of Policy Numbers, Claim Forms, and any other information or documentation necessary for said minor children to be medically insured;
- 7. Pursuant to Civil Code Section 4390.3 et. seq., a wage assignment is granted at the request of the Family Support Division;
- 8. That Defendant be ordered to pay half of all medical, dental, eye care and orthodontic expenses incurred by said minor children that are not covered by insurance;
- 9. That Defendant be ordered to notify the Office of the District Attorney, Amador County, Family Support Division, of all changes of address, occupation, employment, amounts and rates of pay or compensation;
- 10. That Defendant be ordered to provide his annual Federal and State tax returns to the Office of the Amador County District Attorney, Family Support Division, not later than thirty (30) days after said returns are filed, and regardless of whether such returns are made quarterly or annually;
- 11. That the Amador County Family Support Division shall effect service of this Judgment upon the Defendant.
