## ORDER ON SHOW CAUSE PROCEEDINGS

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10 THESE MATTERS came on for consideration before the Honorable 11 Mitchell Karaman on the show cause order initiated by William S. 12 Newell dated July 7, 1992, and on the show cause order initiated 13 by Margaret Brice dated September 28, 1992.

14 Prior to hearing William S. Newell withdrew his claim for 15 satisfaction of all back child support due and owing.

Prior to trial the parties stipulated that child support owed by Father, William S. Newell, to Mother, Margaret Brice, as and for the support of the two minor children of the parties, Stephen W. Newell and Byron Charles Newell, be the sum of \$473 per month, or \$236.50 per month for each child starting

21 November 1, 1992.

22 Prior to trial the parties attended mediation as to child 23 visitation issues, which mediation was successful and is 24 represented by the mediation agreement dated October 12, 1992, a 25 copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and the same is

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1 approved in all things.

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The remaining matter of the issue of contempt of court by Mother for allegedly refusing to permit father to visit the children was heard by the Court and the Court finds that Father did not produce sufficient evidence on which to base a finding of contempt of court;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

8 1. Father, William S. Newell, shall pay to Mother, 9 Margaret Brice, through the Department of Human Resources, P. O. 10 Box 14506, Salem, Oregon 97310, for the care, support and 11 maintenance of the children of the parties the sum of \$236.50 per 12 month per child, or a total of \$473.00 per month commencing 13 November 1, 1992, until said minor children obtain their 14 majority, sooner become emancipated or no longer qualify as 15 children attending school under ORS 107.108.

16 2. Visitation rights by Father, William S. Newell, with 17 the minor children of the parties shall be according to the terms 18 of Exhibit A attached hereto and said terms are hereby adopted as 19 the order of the Court and the parties are ordered to carry out 20 the provisions thereof.

21 3. Margaret Brice is hereby purged of contempt and the 22 said claim by William S. Newell of contempt of court by Margaret 23 Brice is hereby dismissed with prejudice.

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## NOTICE OF INCOME WITHHOLDING

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The Support Order contained in this Decree is enforceable by 2 withholding under ORS 25.310. Withholding may occur income immediately whenever there are arrearages at least equal to the 3 support payment for one month, whenever the obligated parent 4 requests such withholding or whenever the obligee requests withholding for good cause. The District Attorney or, when appropriate, the Support Enforcement Division of the Department 5 Justice will assist in securing such withholding. The of obligated parent's property is also subject to liens and foreclosure thereon, execution, garnishment and interception of 6 unemployment and worker compensation benefits. Past due support 7 (and in paternity cases judgment for blood test costs or birth expenses) may be recovered out of amounts due from state or 8 federal tax refunds, or by other collection action, even when monthly payments are current. 9 This Order will be filed with the County Circuit Court NOTE: 10 Clerk, and will be docketed as Judgment.
