3. IT IS ORDERED, ADJUNGED AND DECREED that Petitioner is awarded the custody of the minor children of the parties, namely: COREY LEE HIGGINS, born November 11, 1982 and LACEY LEANNE HIGGINS, born May 10, 1986, subject to reasonable rights of visitation by Respondent, as aforesaid shall include the following minimum visitation schedule:

The first and third weekend of each month, from Friday at 6:00 p.m. until Sunday at 7:00 p.m.; alternate major holidays including part of the Christmas Vacation, from 4:00 p.m. Christmas Day, and to and including three days after Christmas, Thanksgiving, Labor Day, the 4th of July, Memorial Day and one half of the children's spring vacation. Respondent shall have each child on their respective birthdays from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 ppm. In addition, the Respondent should have the right to visit with the children for an extended period of time not to exceed four weeks each summer, which period shall be selected by the Respondent by the first day of May of each year and the Petitioner so advised in writing.
