(1) To declare this contract cancelled for default and null and void, and to declare the purchaser's rights forfeited and the debt extinguished, and to retain sums previously paid hereunder by the buyer;*

(2) To declare the whole unpaid principal balance of the purchase price with the interest thereon at once due and payable; and/or (3) To foreclose this contract by suit in equity.

In any of such cases, all rights and interest created or then existing in favor of the buyer as against the seller hereunder shall revert to cease and the right to the possession of the premises above described and all other rights acquired by the buyer hereunder shall revert to and revest in the seller without any act of re-entry, or any other act of the seller to be performed and without any right of the buyer of return, reclamation or compensation for moneys paid on account of the purchase of the property as absolutely, fully and perfectly as it return, reclamation or compensation for moneys paid on account of the purchase of the property as absolutely, fully and perfectly as it this contract and such payments had never been made; and in case of such default all payments theretofore made on this contract are to the retained by and belong to the seller as the agreed and reasonable rent of the premises up to the time of such default. In construing this contract, it is understood that the seller or the buyer may be more than one person or a corporation; that if the context so requires, the singular pronoun shall be taken to mean and include the plural and the neuter, and that generally all grammatical changes shall be made, assumed and implied to make the provisions hereot apply equally to corporations and to individuals.

This agreement shall bind and inure to the benetit of, as the circumstances may require, not only the immediate parties hereto but their respective heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors in interest and assigns as well.
