

having been made to the jury, the jury having been regularly instructed in the law and having retired for deliberations did, on the 6th day of September, 1990, return its verdict, which verdict, omitting the title of the court and cause, is in the words and figures as follows: "We, the jury, being duly empaneled and sworn to try the above-entitled case, find just compensation to be paid for the acquisition to be \$3,410. DATED this 6th day of September, 1990. 10 11 Foreperson." 12 It appearing to the court and the court now finds that the 13 amount of the verdict of the jury was more than plaintiff's 14 tender made in writing more than 30 days prior to trial, and 15 that defendant therefore is entitled to its costs and 16 disbursements incurred herein; 17 It appearing to the court from files and records herein 18 that on September 19, 1989, the plaintiff heretofore deposited 19 the sum of \$1,000 with the Clerk of the Court for the use and 20 benefit of the defendant herein; and 21 It further appearing to the Court that plaintiff has now 22 deposited the balance of the verdict over and above the said 23 \$1,000 heretofore deposited, the added sum of \$2,410, plus interest at 9% per annum from September 25, 1989, the date the

plaintiff took possession of the property described herein, to

judgment herein; now, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by this court as follows: That the real property hereinafter described be, and the same hereby is appropriated for public purposes; and title to said property, together with all rights and easements therein be, and the same herein is vested in the State of Oregon, by and through its Department of Transportation, free and clear of 9 all liens and encumbrances except as set forth herein. Said 10 real property so appropriated is described on the attached 11 Exhibit A. 12 2. 13 Plaintiff shall take title of the real property described 14 herein subject to the interest of others than the within named 15 defendant in the following encumbrance: 16 "Rights of Way to The California Oregon Power Company, in Volume 69, Page 442, 17 Volume 69, Page 495, and Volume 80, Page 478." 18 3. 19 Plaintiff and defendant, as a result of a stipulation 20 entered into the record, have stipulated that the highway 21 project adjacent to the Larry Fish property will be constructed 22 as drawn on state's Exhibit 11 and not otherwise, unless 23 changed in a way that is more beneficial to access the adjacent 24 property, and not detrimental to highway access. 25 In the event of any change from Exhibit 11 that is
