ORDER

THE HONOURABLE
MR. JUSTICE TYSOE

FRIDAY, THE 26TH DAY
OF FEBRUARY, 1993

UPON THE APPLICATIONS of the Plaintiff, FANNY DUQUE KELLEMS and the Defendant, RANDOLPH KELLEMS, coming on for hearing before me at Vancouver this date, AND UPON HEARING Rosemary L. Nash, Counsel for the Plaintiff, AND UPON HEARING John O. Richardson Esq., Counsel for the Defendant, AND UPON HEARING AND READING the pleadings herein:

THIS COURT DECLARES that the parties have no prospect of reconciliation with each other pursuant to Section 44 of the Family Relations Act, R.S.B.C. 1979, Chapter 121 on condition that it not be interpreted as a ruling that the Plaintiff has any entitlement to any assets, and, without prejudice to either party, to subsequently prove that there was no reconciliation after July 20, 1990 and before February 26, 1993, and that the effective date for the division of assets is a date other than the date of this Order.

THIS COURT ORDERS that the Plaintiff have interim custody of the child of the marriage, INEZ DUQUE KELLEMS, born August 18, 1980.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Defendant on one week's notice have reasonable access to the child of the marriage of two 48 hour periods per month minimum, with further reasonable access to the Defendant to be agreed upon by the parties, or, failing agreement, by leave of the Court.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Defendant pay interim maintenance to the Plaintiff for support of the Plaintiff and the child of the marriage the amount of \$4,750.00 per month commencing on the 1st day of October, 1992 and continuing on the 1st day of each and every month thereafter.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Plaintiff is restrained from disposing of family assets or any assets of the Defendant presently in possession or control of the Plaintiff subject to two conditions Firstly, if the Defendant defaults in monthly maintenance payments and secondly she may only sell an asset or assets to the extent required to pay for ongoing living expenses, and not in excess of \$5,000.00 with leave of the Court. Assets having an aggregate value over \$5,000.00 are not to be sold during any two month period without leave of the Court.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Defendant is restrained from disposing of, encumbering, transferring, hypothecating or dealing with in any way the family assets or other property at issue except for the purpose of making payments pursuant to the Order herein.

THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS that the Defendant deliver forthwith to the Plaintiff his current Property and Financial Statement in form 91 together with attachments referred to in Rule 60A(2)(b).

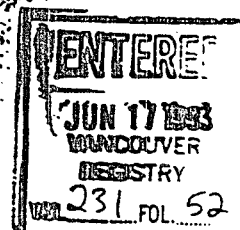
