- 1. - 4. To obtain Beneficiary's written consent before selling or transferring the property, or any part thereof, and any such sale or transfer without Beneficiary's prior written consent shall constitute a default under the terms hereof.
- 5. - 2. By accepting payment of any sum secured hereby after its due date, Beneficiary does not waive its right to require prompt payment when due of all other sums so secured or to declare default for failure to so pay.
- 3. The Trustee shall reconvey all or any part of the property covered by this Deed of Trust to the person entitled thereto, on written request of the Grantor and the Beneficiary, or upon satisfaction of the obligation secured and written request for reconveyance made by the Beneficiary or the person entitled thereto.
- 4. In such event and upon written request of Beneficiary, Trustee shall sell the trust property, in accordance with the Trust Deed Act of the State of Orogen, at public auction to the highest bidder. Any person except Trustee may bid at Trustee's sale.
