ORDER

THIS matter came before the Planning Commission for Klamath County, Oregon on February 22, 1994. The hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related ordinances. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Carl Shuck and the recording secretary was Karen Burg.

The staff report was received. Based on the evaluation of the report and evidence received, the planning commission makes the following findings of fact and conclusions and makes the following decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The applicant requests a conditional ues permit to establish the development of mini warehouse complex and a worker residence in the overlay airport zone. The subject property is 5.14 acres in size, located in a portion of section 15 of TS 39 R9, Tax Lot 100. The property received the zoning approval of IL(Light Industrial) from the Board of Commissoiners on February 22, 1994. The site for the development has access off of Altamont Drive. Altamont Drive can carry the kind of traffic that will be generated by the type of development that will be developed. The type of development will not have an adverse impact on surrounding properties as there are similar uses on the abutting properties. Article 58.020 (B) of the Klamath County Land Development Code provides the authority for granting the requested conditional use permit.

CONCLUSION:

The development meets the size, design and the proposed use will not have an adverse impact on surrounding development or value of abutting properties. The use is in conformance with other required criteria of this code.
