This matter came before Michael L. Brant, Hearings Officer for Klamath County, Oregon, on May 13, 1994, in the Klamath County Planning Department Conference Room in Klamath Falls, Oregon. The hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related statutes and ordinances. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Mr. Kim Lundahl and the recording secretary was Ms. Karen Burg. The staff report was received. Based upon the evaluation of the staff report and consideration of the evidence received, the hearings officer makes the following findings of fact and conclusions and makes the following decision.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The applicant requests a conditional use permit to establish a shotgun target range on 80 acres north and west of Lawanda Hills which is situated generally west of Klamath Falls, Oregon. The proposed site is TL 3908-000-2200 which is portions of the E 1/2 NE 1/4 S15, T 39S, R 8 EWM, and zoned Non Resource. Access is by way of the Lawanda Hills roadnet.

Authority for granting the requested permit is found in Article 56.030 D of the Klamath County Land Development Code. Article 44 of said code sets out the requirements for establishing the requested permit in conjunction with the NR zone.

CONCLUSION

The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed use will not have a significant adverse impact on the livibilty, value or appropriate development of abutting properties and the surrounding area.

1. The applicant must obtain the required permit and approval, from the Klamath County Environmental Health Service, for restroom facilities.
