MORTGAGE

CONVEYANCE

Giovanni Mangione (Mortgagor), in consideration of the conditional essential services grant of twenty six thousand and ⁰⁰/₁₀₀ dollars (\$26,000), made available under the Underground Storage Tank Financial Assistance Program (ORS 466.705 to 466.835 as amended by Chapter 863 Oregon Laws, 1991), convey to Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (Mortgagee) the property described as Bonanza Minimart, Bonanza, OR, and located in Klamath County, Oregon. The legal description of the property being:

Parcel 1: lots 1 & 2 Block 5 except the westerly 10 feet of original town of BONANZA in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon
Parcel 2: The easterly 100 ft of lots 8, 9, & 10, and the west 10 ft of lots 1 & 2 Block 5 original town of BONANZA in the County of Klamath, State of Oregon

Code # App 3911-1000 - TL 1700

INTENT OF THE PARTIES AS TO THE EFFECT OF THIS MORTGAGE

This mortgage is intended to secure the reimbursement of the essential services grant in full if the mortgagor should not satisfy any condition of the grant.

CONDITIONS OF THE GRANT

The mortgagor shall repay the grant in full if the mortgagor or his legal representatives sells the above property or business reselling motor fuel within five years after receiving the latest grant disbursement. The latest grant disbursement is due to be received on May 26, 1994. If the mortgagor sells the property or business reselling motor fuel on or before May 26, 1999, without reimbursing the mortgagee the full amount of the grant, the mortgagor will not satisfy this condition.



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MORTGAGE (Continued)

EFFECT OF SATISFACTION OF GRANT CONDITIONS

If the property or business reselling motor fuel is not sold on or before May 26, 1999, this mortgage shall be void. If the mortgagor reimburses the mortgagee the full amount of the grant, this mortgage shall be void.

EFFECT OF NOT SATISFYING GRANT CONDITIONS

If the property or business reselling motor fuel is sold on or before May 26, 1999, and the mortgagor fails to repay the grant in full, then the mortgagee and his legal representatives may foreclose on this mortgage. Proceeds from the foreclosure and sale of the property sufficient to reimburse the mortgagee for the full amount of the grant may be retained by the mortgagee.

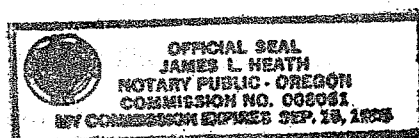

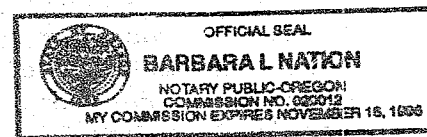
