FINDINGS OF FACT

Respondent has maintained more than one inoperable vehicle on property located at 474 Alva, Klamath Falls, Oregon.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Respondent is in violation of the Klamath County Land Development Code.

ORDER

Respondent shall remove or cause to be removed to a legal location all but one inoperable vehicle by September 5, 1994.

In the event William Parsons fails to comply with this order the Code Enforcement Officer shall cite Mr. Parsons into Klamath County District Court with bail set at \$500.00.
