Emery Trust Under Date 1/31/94, its heirs, successors and assigns hereinafter Grantee, a nonexclusive easement to use all existing roads on, over and across the following described real property as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and by this reference incorporated herein:

Page 28850. Official Records, Klamath County, Oregon.
- 2. Grantors reserve the right to use, construct, reconstruct and maintain the roads located upon the easement. The parties shall cooperate so that each party's use shall cause a minimum of interference to the others.
- 3. Grantee agrees to indemnify and defend Grantors from any loss, claim or liability to Grantors arising in any manner out of Grantee's use of the easement. Grantee shall pay Grantors for any property of Grantors damaged by Grantee's use of this easement. Grantee assumes all risk arising out of its use of the easement and Grantors shall have no liability to Grantee or others for any condition existing thereon. Grantee agrees and represents that Grantee is accepting the easement on the premises "AS IS".
