This matter came before Michael L. Brant, Hearings Officer for Klamath County, Oregon, on September 2, 1994, in the Klamath County Museum Meeting Room in Klamath Falls, Oregon. The hearing was held pursuant to notice given in conformity with the Klamath County Land Development Code and related statutes and ordinances. The Klamath County Planning Department was represented by Mr. Kim Lundahl and the recording secretary was Ms. Karen Burg. The Klamath County Planning Department file and all the exhibits and other contents therein is incorporated by this reference into this matter.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

The applicants are requesting a conditional use permit to 1. establish a second residence, a mobile home, on 5.95 acres zoned R-1.

The property is situated north of Elderberry Lane, 500 feet 2. east of Shady Pine Road, Shady Pine, and is legally described as T.A. 3709-31DB-100, a portion of the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 S31, T37S, R9EWM. The property is accessed from Elderberry Lane.

3. The mobile home is to replace a unit which had been removed from the same location more than twelve months ago. The infrastructure to support the replacement unit is in place.

4. The authority for granting the requested conditional use permit is found in Article 51.3, section 51.330 (B) and (L).

6. The proposed use is in conformance with all other required standards and criteria of the Klamath County Land Development Code.

7. The location, size, design and operating characteristics of the proposed use will not have a significant adverse impact on the livibility, value or approportiate development of abutting properties or the surrounding area.

## CONCLUSIONS

There is no reasonable basis upon which to deny the applicants' request.

## ORDER

Based upon the findings and conclusion herein, the conditional use permit application is approved upon the following conditions:

A placement permit must be obtained, or an extension of time granted, within two years of the date of approval. If neither event occurs, this approval is void.
