- 2.1 Possession. Until in default, Gran or in tyremain in possession and control of and operate and manage the Property and collect the Income from the Property.
- 2.2 Duty to Maintain. Grantor shall maintain the Property n first class condition and promptly perform all repairs and maintenance necessary to preserve its value.
- 2.3 Nuisance, Waste, Grantor shall be the conduct or permit my nuisance nor commit or suffer any strip or waste on or to the Property or any portion thereof including without limitation removal or alienation by Grantor of the right to remove any timber, minerals (including oil and gas), or gravel.or rock products.
- 2.4 Removal of Improvements, Gran or shall not demolish to remove any improvements from the Real Property without the prior written consent of Credit Union. Credit Union. shall consent if Grantor mates, arrangements satisfactory to Credit Union to replace any improvement which Grantor proposes to remove with one of at least equal value. "Improvements" shall include all existing and future buildings, structures, and parking facilities.
- 2.5 Credit Union Right to Enter. Credit Union, its agents and representatives, may enter upon the Property at all reasonable times to attend to Credit Union's interest and to inspect the Property.

- 2.6 Compliance with Governmental Requirements. Grantor shall promptly comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations of all governmental authorities applicable to the use or occupancy of the Property Grantor may contest in good faith any such law ordinance, or regulation and withhold compliance during a proceeding, including appropriate appeals, so long as Grantor has notified Credit Union in writing prior, to doing so and Credit Union's interest in the Property is not jeopardized. Credit Union may require Grantor to post adequate security (reasonably satisfactory to Credit Union) to potect Credit Union's interest.
- 2.7 Duty of Protect. Grantor shall do all other acts, in addition to those set forth in this section, that from the character and use of the Property are reasonably necessary to protect and preserve the security.

- 3.1 Payment. Grantor shall maintain the Property free of any liens having priority over or equal to the interest of Credit Union under this Deed of Trust, except for the lien of taxes and assessments not due, except for the prior indebted ess referred to in frection 17, and except as otherwise provided in Subsection 3.2.
- 3.2 Right to Contest. Grantor may withhold payment of any tax, assessment, or claim in connection with a good faith dispute over the obligation to pay, so long as Credit Union's interest in the Property's not jeopardized. If a lien arises or is filed as a result of nonpayment, Grantor shall within 15 days after the lien arises or, i 'alled is filed, within 17 days after Grantor has notice of the filing, secure the discharge of the lien or deposit with Credit Union, cash or a sufficient corporate surety bend or other security satisfactory to Credit Union in an amount sufficient to discharge the lien plus any costs, attorneys' see, or other charges that could accrue as a result of a foreclosure or sale under the lien.
- 3.3 Evidence of Payment. Grantor shall upon demand furnich to Credit Union evidence of payment of the taxes or assessments and shall authorize the appropriate county official to deliver to Credit Union at any time a written statement of the taxes and assessments against the Property.
- 3.4 Notice of Construction. Grantor thall notify Credit Unit at least 15 days before any work is commenced, any services are furnished, or any materials are supplied to the Property if a construction lied could be asserted on account of the work, services, or materials, and the cost exceeds \$5,000 (if the Property is used for no tresidential or commercial purposes) or \$1,000 (if the Property is used as a residence). Grantor will on request furnish to Credit Union advance assurances satisfactory to Credit Union that Grantor can and will pay the cost of such Improvements.
- 3.5 Tax Reserves. Subject to any limitations set by applicable law, Credit Union may require Borrower to maintain with Credit Union reserves for payment of taxes and assessments, which reserves shall be created by advance payment or monthly payments of a sum estimated by Credit Union to be sufficient to produce, at least 15 days before the, amounts at least equal to the taxes and assessments to be paid. If 15 days before payment is due the reserve funds are nsufficient, Borrower shall upon demand pay any deficiency to Credit Union. The reserve funds shall be held by Credit Union as a general deposit from Borrower and shill constitute a noninterest bearing debt from Credit Union to Borrower, which Credit Union may satisfy by payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower as they become due. Credit Union does not hold the reserve funds in trust for Borrower, and (redit Union is not the agent of Borrower for payment of the taxes and assessments required to be paid by Borrower.
- 4.1 Maintenance of Insurance. Grantor shall procure and maintain policies of fire insurance with standard all risk extended coverage endorsements on a replacement basis for the full insurable value is sis covering all Improvements on the Real Property in an amount sufficient to avoid application of any coinsurance clause and with a mortgagee's loss payable clause in favor of Credit Union. Policies shall be written by such insurance companies and in such form as may be reasonably acceptable to Credit Union. Grantor shall deliver to Credit Union certificates of coverage from each insurer containing a stipulation that coverage will not be cancelled or diminished without a minimum of 10 days' written notice to Credit Union.
- 4.2 Application of Proceeds. Granter shall promptly notify Credit Union of any loss or damage to the Property. Credit Union may make proof of loss if Granter fails to do so withir 15 days of the casualty. Credit Union may, at its election, apply the proceeds to the reduction of the Indebtedness or the restoration and repair of the Property. If Credit Union elects to apply the proceeds to restoration and repair, Granter shall repair or replace the damaged or destroyed Imprevements in a manner satisfactory to Credit Union. Credit Union shall, upon satisfactory proof of such expenditure, pay or reimburse Granter from the proceeds for the reasonable cost of repair or restoration if Granter is not in default hereunder. Any proceeds which have not been paid out within 180 days after their receipt and which Credit Union has not committed to the repair or restoration of the Property shall be used to prepay first accrued interest and then principal of the Indebtedness. If Credit Union holds any proceeds after payment in full of the Indebtedness, such proceeds shall be paid to Granter.
- 4.3 Unexpired Insurance at Sale. Any unexpired insurance shall inure to the benefit of, and pass to, the purchaser of the Property covered this Deed of Trust at any trustee's or other sale held under the provision contained within, or at any foreclosure sale of such Property.
- 4.4 Compliance with Prior Indebt dness, During the period in which any prior Indebtedness described in Section 17 is in effect, compliance with the insurance provisions ontained in the instrument evidencing such prior Indebtedness shall constitute compliance with the insurance provisions under this Deed of Trust of the extent compliance with the terms of this Deed of Trust would constitute a duplication of insurance requirements.
