FINDINGS OF FACT

Respondent has maintained residential use in recreational vehicles on property generally located at 37566 Rollingwood Lane in Klamath County, Oregon, Lot 6, Block 1, T 1168, T.A. 3508-1-1400. Respondent occupied a recreational vehicle which Respondent caused to be removed after learning of Code Enforcement proceedings. Respondent now occupies a second recreational vehicle on the property.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

Respondent is in violation.

ORDER

Respondent shall discontinue occupancy the recreational vehicle immediately and shall not occupy any recreational vehicle on the

property without complying with the Klamath County Land Development Code.
